Community Usage Policy

1. Policy Connections

National Standards for Disability Services, Disability Services Act 1986 (Commonwealth), Disability Discrimination Act 1992 (Commonwealth).

2. Policy Statement

Directions will allow members of the public who have a disability, and their accompanying family and carers to share use of the accessible bathroom at 8 Blackburn Street, Maddington WA 6109 during business hours.

3. Roles and responsibilities

Directions will:

- Allow people with a disability and their accompanying family and carers to enter the Volunteer Centre to access the bathroom during business hours;
- Maintain the bathroom and its equipment in a safe, clean and hygienic condition with appropriate cleaning and sundry supplies;
- Maintain all necessary public indemnity insurance.

Users of the accessible bathroom will:

- Utilise the bathroom and its equipment in a safe manner at all times;
- Ensure that the bathroom is in a clean and hygienic condition before leaving;
- Not undertake any activity that would be likely to damage the bathroom or its contents;
- Not spend more than 20 minutes in the bathroom without prior permission of Directions;
- Not undertake any activity that would disturb the activities taking place in the Volunteer Centre;
